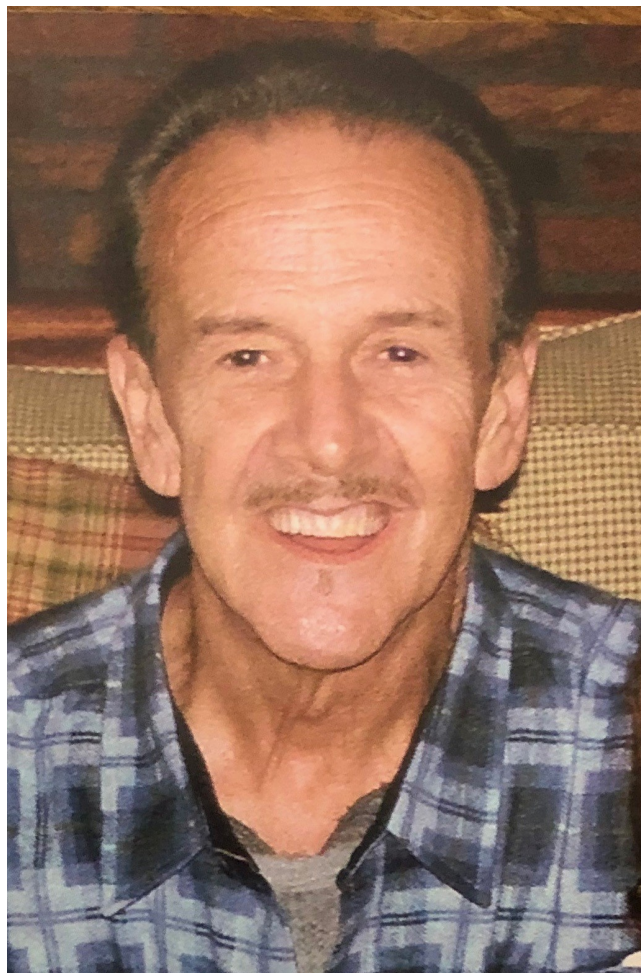


## Donald E. Nadeau
